Minoru Makihara (1930-2020)

The Japan-America Society of Dallas/Fort Worth is saddened to learn of the recent death of Minoru Makihara, who was a member of the JASDFW advisory council and was the 2013 recipient of the Sun & Star Legacy Award. He served as the President and CEO of the

Mitsubishi Corporation in the 1990s, when it was the largest company in the world.

Makihara was also a long-time supporter of Japan's relations with the United States, serving as chairman of notable organizations fostering U.S.-Japan business, cultural, and educational exchange.


